Wednesday Discipleship Classes (Classes start September 16)

- **Truth Project** lead by Mike Porter - The Truth Project is a ground-breaking small group curriculum on the Biblical worldview. This video-based Bible study is the starting point for looking at life from a biblical perspective. Join Dr. Del Tackett, as he takes you through 13 engaging video lessons on the relevance and importance of living the Biblical worldview in daily life. *This class will meet at 6:30 pm in Grace 319.*
- **Doing Life with Your Adult Children** lead by David Jones - Dealing with boundaries, finances, and changing values are all part of parenting your grown child. In *Doing Life with Your Adult Children*, Jim Burns offers practical advice and hopeful encouragement for one of the richest and most challenging seasons of parenting. This study will be focused on parents of high school and college age children. *This class will meet at 6:30 pm in Grace 305.*
- **The Book of Acts** lead by Steve Miller - this Bible study documents the rise and spread of the gospel across the known world. Luke's work serves as a bridge from the life of Christ to the birth of the first church, revealing both the successes and the inevitable growing pains as the movement spread from Jerusalem, to Judea, to Samaria, and to the rest of the world. *This class will meet at 6:30 pm in Grace 313.*
- **Help My Unbelief** lead by David & Margret Sterling - All of us have questions about faith, but we often feel awkward or uncomfortable asking them. This six week Bible study invites us into a larger faith—one that has room for questions, victories, failures, and mystery. Belief in an infinite God by finite humans is an act of exploration. It's a process of learning all we can understand and trusting God in all we can't. *This class will meet at 6:30 pm in Grace 306.*

Sunday Discipleship Classes *(Classes will start September 13)*

- **Breaking through towards Spiritual Maturity (Online)** *lead by Jim Fannin* - This study will give you simple, action-oriented steps to improve your relationship with God, with others, and most importantly, yourself as God intended. Regardless of your spiritual maturity, this study will broaden your perspective in understanding God and His Word. *This class will meet online at 5 pm.*
- **Search for Significance** *lead by Dorothy Jones* - This 8-week Bible study gives practical learning activities that help believers apply God's truth, and gain a real sense of self-worth. Christians need to be aware of Satan's lies in order to recognize God's truth. Once aware of that truth, believers can then build a healthy view of themselves as they renew their minds. *This class will meet at 5:00 pm in Grace 306.*
- **Choosing a Life that Matters** *lead by Humberto Saldivar* - We live in a world of shifting truths. How can we find our moral and spiritual footing? Helping you navigate the crossroads of culture and Christianity, this Bible study encourages you to seek, fear, love, believe, obey, serve, and worship God as you stand strong against our anything-goes culture---and live a life that echoes into eternity. *This class will meet at 5:00 pm in Grace 319.*
- **The Promised Land** *lead by Nick Vann* - This 5-week Bible study will illustrate how God guided his people to a specific place – the Promised Land – to impact the world both in ancient times and today. By weaving together the Bible's fascinating historical, cultural, religious, and geographical contexts, teacher and historian Ray Vander Lan reveals unique insights into the Scriptures' significance for modern believers. *This class will meet at 5:00 pm in Grace 305.*
- **The Revelation of Jesus Christ** *lead by Jim Brown* - This is a 4-semester, 2-year study of the Book of Revelation. Semester 3 will start with the opening the seventh Seal that starts the Trumpet Judgements. What will life on planet Earth be like during the Great Tribulation and the Beast as the world ruler? This semester covers Revelation chapters 9 through 14 and takes an in-depth look at Satan. *This class will meet at 5:00 pm in Grace 313.*
