Getting the Gospel Right in an Age of Apostasy

It is imperative for Believers to understand the Gospel according to Scripture, not only for the comfort, joy and assurance of their own salvation, but for the salvation of those who need to hear the true Gospel. In this study, we will survey the gospel as proclaimed in Scripture. In covering several points, we will answer questions like: What is the Gospel? What are the non-negotiable elements of the message? What makes us right and others wrong? Don't all Evangelicals believe the same gospel? Does it really matter as long as you are sincere?
