BOOK OF GENESIS - The Book of Genesis is one of two important key books of the Bible. The book that opens the Old Testament (Genesis) and the book that opens the New Testament (Matthew) are the two books which I feel are the key to the understanding of the Scriptures. Genesis is a book that states many things for the first time: God, creation, man, woman, Satan, sin, Sabbath, marriage, family, labor, civilization, culture, murder, death, sacrifice, races, languages, redemption, and cities. There are two ways of studying the Bible; one is with the telescope and the other way is with the microscope. This study in Genesis is a microscope study and may take up to three years of Discipleship Training Classes. *This 12-week study will be led by Jim Brown.
